# **West India Birding Tour**

Kashmir, Punjab, Rajasthan, Gujarat & Maharashtra

(21 Days)

(Can be combined with Northeast India)

This grand tour of western India takes us through five bird-rich states. Beginning in the high-altitude valleys of Kashmir, we'll search for wintering finches and endemics like Orange Bullfinch before flying to Punjab, where marshes hold Sind Sparrow and Rufous-vented Grass Babbler. We then head through the arid and semi-arid habitats of Rajasthan and Gujarat in search of rarities such as the Great Indian Bustard, Macqueen's Bustard, Hypocolius, Stoliczka's Bushchat, and finally to Maharashtra for the oncemythical Forest Owlet. Mammals such as Indian Wild Ass, Striped Hyena, Blackbuck, and perhaps Leopard add to the excitement.

## **Itinerary (2027):-**

#### Day 1

Arrive Delhi and connect to **Srinagar** (Kashmir). Afternoon birding around Srinagar. Night in Srinagar.

## Days 2-3

Two full days birding in Srinagar region. Key species: **Orange Bullfinch**, **Kashmir & White-cheeked Nuthatch**, **Rufous-naped Tit**, **Spectacled Finch**, **Kashmir Nutcracker**, **Black-throated Thrush**, and chances of **Blyth's Rosefinch**. Nights in Srinagar

## **Day 4**

Fly from Srinagar to Amritsar (Punjab). Night in Amritsar

#### Day 5

Birding at Harike Wetlands. Main targets: Rufous-vented Grass Babbler, Sind Sparrow, White-tailed Stonechat, Jerdon's Babbler, Moustached Warbler, Mountain Chiffchaff. Night in Amritsar

#### Day 6

Early birding at Harike, then long drive to **Tal Chhapar (Rajasthan).** Night at Tal Chhapar

#### **Day 7**

Full day birding Tal Chhapar. Highlights: Indian Spotted-creeper,

Demoiselle Crane, Indian Eagle Owl, Rock Bush Quail, Steppe Eagle,

Blackbuck, White-bellied Minivet. Night at Tal Chhapar

#### Day 8

Pre-dawn visit to **Bikaner dump** for **Yellow-eyed Dove**, then drive to **Jaisalmer**. Optional afternoon birding. Night in Jaisalmer

## Days 9-10

Full birding in Desert National Park. Priority: **Great Indian Bustard, Stoliczka's Bushchat, Cream-coloured Courser, Chestnut-bellied Sandgrouse, Asian Desert Warbler, Steppe & Imperial Eagle, Vultures.**Nights in Jaisalmer

#### **Day 11**

Drive to **Siana** (chance of Striped Hyena, **White-bellied Minivet,** Painted Sandgrouse). Night in Siana

#### **Day 12**

Full day birding in Siana with morning and afternoon jeep safaris. Night in Siana

#### **Day 13**

Early drive to Mount Abu for Green Avadavat, White-capped & Crested Buntings, then to Little Rann of Kutch. Night at Little Rann of Kutch

#### **Day 14**

Morning and afternoon safaris in the Little Rann. Highlights: Macqueen's Bustard, Sykes's Nightjar, Pallid Scops Owl, Indian Wild Ass, Greater Hoopoe Lark, Flamingos, Raptors. Night at Little Rann of Kutch

#### **Day 15**

Drive west to **Bhuj**, birding en route. Targets: **Sykes's Lark, White-naped Tit, Marshall's Iora, Painted Sandgrouse.** Night in Bhuj

## Days 16-17

Full birding in and around Bhuj. Specialties: **Hypocolius, Sociable Lapwing, White-naped Tit, Crab Plover, Red-tailed Wheatear, Dalmatian Pelican, Indian Eagle Owl.** Nights in Bhuj

#### **Day 18**

Fly from Bhuj to Mumbai, then drive to forested reserve for Forest Owlet.

**Night at Forest Owlet reserve** 

#### **Day 19**

Full day for Forest Owlet and other species: Mottled Wood Owl, Vigors's Sunbird, Indian Paradise Flycatcher, Jungle Owlet, Western Crowned Warbler. Night near reserve area of Tansa.

#### Day 20 -

Final morning birding. Return to Mumbai for farewell dinner.

Night near **Mumbai** Airport

## Day 21 – March

International departures from Mumbai.

Northeast India – Early March 2026 (Contact for details)
